Amendment to the Standing Orders of the House of Commons

Ottawa, Ontario – September 21, 2023

On Monday, September 18, the House of Commons adopted a permanent change to the Standing Orders of the House of Commons. This amendment applies to the days when the House is not to sit, namely Saint-Jean-Baptiste Day, Canada Day and the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. If these days fall on a Saturday or a Sunday, the House shall not meet the following Monday.

The amendment came into force on September 18, 2023, and the House of Commons Sitting Calendar was adjusted accordingly.
