**The Chair (Hon. Hedy Fry (Vancouver Centre, Lib.)):** I call the committee to order. Just in case we have to run out again soon, I'd like us to get at least three paragraphs of our report done.

Before we go in camera to deal with the report, I think Ms. Dabrusin has just tabled a motion with the clerk.

Ms. Dabrusin, would you like to read your motion?

**Ms. Julie Dabrusin (Toronto—Danforth, Lib.):** Thank you, Madam Chair.

I move:

That the Committee undertake a study of at least 5 meetings on cultural hubs and cultural districts in Canada, including their economic impacts, their effects on arts and culture in Canada, the role they play in city building, and how the federal government can foster and support their development.
