Ottawa, Ontario – March 7, 2017

In celebration of International Women’s Day on Wednesday, March 8, a [Daughters of the Vote](#) (DOV) event, organized by [Equal Voice Canada](#), will take place in the House of Commons Chamber.

The 338 “Daughters of the Vote” delegates—each woman representing a federal constituency in Canada— have been invited to occupy their Member of Parliament’s seat in the Chamber as the representative for their community.

The keynote speech will be delivered by the Right Honourable Kim Campbell, 19th Prime Minister of Canada. Her address will be followed by statements from some of the delegates and remarks from all federal Party leaders.
