Speakers of the Lower Houses of the G7 meet in Halifax

Halifax, Nova Scotia – September 6, 2018

The Honourable Geoff Regan, P.C., M.P., Speaker of the House of Commons, is hosting the 16th Meeting of the Speakers of the Lower Houses of the G7, which will begin with a welcome reception this evening and run until Saturday, September 8.

The theme of this year's gathering is "Parliamentary Oversight and National Security." A number of business sessions, meetings, and visits are planned, including a visit by the presiding officers to the prestigious Ocean Frontier Institute at Dalhousie University.

"I am proud to welcome my G7 counterparts to the beautiful province of Nova Scotia for this meeting and I look forward to engaging in important discussions with them," said this year's host, Speaker Regan.
