Annual Report on the *Members of the House of Commons*Workplace Harassment and Violence Prevention Policy for 2020– 2021

Ottawa, Ontario – June 10, 2021

The <u>Annual Report on the Members of the House of Commons Workplace Harassment and Violence Prevention Policy 2020–2021</u> is now available on ourcommons.ca. The report covers the period from April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021.

The report forms part of the <u>Members of the House of Commons Workplace Harassment and Violence Prevention Policy</u>, adopted by the Board of Internal Economy on January 28, 2021, and replaces the House of Commons Policy on Preventing and Addressing Harassment, approved by the Board on December 9, 2014. The new policy responds to the regulations established under Part II of the Canada Labour Code that came into effect on January 1, 2021.

The policy mandates the Chief Human Resources Officer to publish a report every year on the number, nature, and outcome of harassment and violence complaints. This report reflects the Board's ongoing commitment to ensuring transparency for Canadians and to maintaining a safe, healthy, and harassment-free workplace for Members and their staff.
