## Suspension of proof of vaccination against COVID-19 within the House of Commons precinct

Ottawa, Ontario – June 16, 2022

The Honourable Anthony Rota, in his role as Chair of the Board of Internal Economy, reports that the Board has decided to suspend the requirement for individuals to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to be allowed within the House of Commons Precinct. This decision is effective as of June 20, 2022.

Until further notice, the measures regarding the use of masks in the House of Commons precinct remain in place until June 23, 2022. For more information on the mandatory use of masks in the House of Commons precinct, please read this <u>statement</u>.

The health and safety of all individuals entering the House of Commons precinct remains a priority. Anyone who is experiencing <u>cold</u>, <u>flu or COVID-like symptoms</u>, or who has been in close contact with someone who is experiencing these symptoms, is reminded not to access the House of Commons precinct.
